<u>Stryker</u>

Andrea with Stryker presented the court with the information that if the court decided to sign a two year contract with Stryker that any repairs that may need to be performed on the ambulances that it would all be covered in the contract and the county wouldn't have to be paying separate bills for each job that in the end would end up costing the county more money. Stryker would also provide a once a year service for the each ambulance to make sure everything on the vehicle is running correctly. The court requested that Stryker return to court to answer further questions and discuss at a later date.

Happy Hollow- Mic Dunaway

Mic Dunaway and Shanen Moore presented the court with thanks for the dumpster for clean-up day and for allowing them to speak with the court. Mic explained to the court that Happy Hollow needs the court's help with a severe drug problem that has become aware in the Happy Hollow area. The court explained that the Sheriff's office was instructed that Happy Hollow was a private resort and was not a loud to enter the facility unless invited in. County Attorney Nick Marsh suggested that Mic and Shanen write and letter to both the Sheriff's office and the Kentucky State Police inviting them into the resort when necessary

Easement for Kentucky Wired

County Judge Comments

- Stacie Rockaway came to court just to see if the court had any concerns
 - The court questioned CSX and what was going on with the whistles, Stacie explained that they have to alert the community they are crossing and with how short the distance is between crossings it may just be easier to hold the whistle.
- Sheriff presented the court with the proposal of appointing a part time deputy. The new deputy would be certified, and continuously going to school over the years.
 - Nick Marsh asks the Sheriff if there is money in the budget for the extra part time person. The sheriff explains that the new deputy would not need insurance and isn't in it for the pay so the amount wasn't much of a concern for the deputy.
 - Magistrate Graham makes a motion to hire the part time deputy. Motion dies due to concern with the budget.
 - The court instructed the Sheriff to bring back a budget, how much they plan to pay the new deputy and a proposal for further consideration.
- Judge Westrick would like to thank the public for his patience during the construction at the county park.

County Attorney Comments

 There is an EMT in school to become a paramedic and is wanting to perform his clinical hours with Carroll County runs.
