### Northkey Discussion

- Aquatics Director Chuck Roberts provided the court with the attached report. Magistrate Long asked Chuck how many lifeguards are needed at a time at the county pool.
- Parks & Recreation JP Dale provided the court with the attached report. Magistrate Long asked JP to provide a report of the enrollment count for all sports for the past two years.
- EMS/EMA Director Tony Crutcher was absent due to training. Tony provided the court with the attached report.
- Director of Government Services Matt Adkins provided the court with the attached report.
- Jailer Daniel Rose stated the 2<sup>nd</sup> inspection was fine minus a few things that the court was aware of. The windows, vent covers and toilets are a few examples of items that have issues.
