A regular meeting of the Carroll County Fiscal Court was held on Tuesday, June 27th, 2023. Members present were Judge Executive David Wilhoite, Magistrate Benjie Long, Magistrate Clay Cable, Magistrate Scott Nab and County Attorney Nick Marsh. Judge Wilhoite called the meeting to order at 9 a.m.

Pledge of Allegiance

Judge Wilhoite opened the meeting with the Pledge of Allegiance and a prayer.

Approve Minutes

Magistrate Long made a motion to approve the minutes from the meeting on June 13th, 2023. Magistrate Nab 2nd. All in favor. Motion carries.

NAS Bond Issue - Bill Jones

Bill Jones from North American Stainless presented the court with an ordinance authorizing the issuance of up to \$80,000,000 principal amount of the county of Carroll, Kentucky taxable industrial building revenue bonds, series 2023. County Attorney Nick Marsh reviewed the documents and recommended a first reading. Magistrate Cable made a motion to have the 1st reading of the ordinance. Magistrate Nab 2nd. All in favor. Motion carries.

Kysoc Risk Assessment

County Attorney Nick Marsh presented the court with a list of recommendations to reduce the liability at Camp Kysoc. Judge Wilhoite stated he has requested quotes on removing the climbing tower. Magistrate Nab questioned if these recommendations would be only at Kysoc. Nick Marsh stated any recommendations would need to carry over to the County Park and any other public land.

Kysoc Pool Update

Judge Wilhoite stated the Kysoc pool has passed State inspection, however there are a few things that need to be addressed for the local inspection, such as housekeeping and signage.

Permit for Use of Courthouse Lawn

County Attorney Nick Marsh spoke with the KACO attorney regarding permitting for using the Courthouse lawn. County Attorney needs the Fiscal Court to decide what the restrictions would be and what the permit process would look like. Also, those who use the Courthouse lawn for events would need to obtain event insurance unless the event is sponsored by the County.

West Prong Locust Bridge Repairs

Judge Wilhoite stated the bridge repairs have been done and the weight limit is back to 33 ton. The Road Department did a great job.

Department Head Reports

- Solid Waste Director PJ Knight provided the court with the attached report. Magistrate Nab made the recommendation to tighten down on the nuisance ordinance. County Attorney Nick Marsh stated having a code enforcement board would give the local more control and the money would return to the county instead of the state.
- Animal Shelter Director Theresa Hehe provided the court with the attached report.
- Senior Center Director Frances Steurer was absent.
- Road Department Director Geno Clayton provided the court with the attached report. Geno also stated if the Fiscal Court is planning on having roads paved, they might want to consider milling them.
- Parks & Recreation Director
 - o JP Dale gave a report on the upcoming events for Parks & Recreation.
 - JP also stated that yellow jackets will need new helmets and uniforms since the ones they currently use are 8 years old.
 - JP is currently waiting on KU to mark the lines at the Pickleball court, they are hoping to finish by July 1st. JP is also in contact with a few groups about pickleball leagues.
 - Magistrate Nab thanked JP and his staff for all the work they do. Magistrate Nab went out to the complex and everything was running smoothly.
- EMS/EMS Director Tony Crutcher provided the court with an update on runs YTD.
- Director of Government Services Matt Adkins provided the court with the attached report.
 Matt also recommended the court adopting the current administrative code for the upcoming fiscal year and making any changes as needed. Magistrate Cable made a motion to read the resolution adopting the policies and procedures and administrative code for CCFC for FYE June 30,2024. Magistrate Nab 2nd. All in favor. Motion carries.

- Sheriff Ryan Gosser presented the court with an update on service calls YTD. He also stated his 2 new vehicles are at L&W and there is a 4-5 week turn around. Magistrate Nab questioned how he was doing with deputies. Ryan stated he has a few candidates but they will have to go to the academy.
- County Clerk Danielle Kinman was absent.

Judge's Comments

- Road department did an excellent job mowing. There are a couple places the road department fixed last week and waiting on asphalt. We might need to look at a different place to get asphalt for several small projects.
- Thanks to the road department & all the staff.
- There is ongoing work on I-71 and there will be traffic issues.
- There is a new representative for State Hwy Department District 6.
- There was an issue with the KY River Bridge and hopefully they got it taken care of.

County Attorney Comments

The County Clerk tax sale will be the 3rd week of July and several letters have been sent out from his office. The deadline for contracts for payment plans for delinquent taxes is July 17th.

Magistrate Comments

Nab – Need to look at getting flashers and bells for the railroad crossing on Four Mile. County Attorney Nick Marsh stated the owner of the road bares the cost and it is roughly \$300,000. Scott mentioned the road has been paved and the railroad crossing markings need to be replaced.

Cable – thanks to all the county employees. Appreciates the Jail and everything they do. The ambulance barn does look completely different since the upgrades.

Long – thanks to everyone. Culverts on Ghent Eagle South need to be extended. Also, needs to get with JP to give the contact information for KU.
