# Carroll County Fiscal Court Minutes September 12, 2023

A regular meeting of the Carroll County Fiscal Court was held on Tuesday, September 12, 2023. Members present were Judge Executive David Wilhoite, Magistrate Benjie Long, Magistrate Clay Cable, Magistrate Scott Nab and County Attorney Nick Marsh. Judge Wilhoite called the meeting to order at 9 a.m.

#### Pledge of Allegiance

Judge Wilhoite opened the meeting with the Pledge of Allegiance and a prayer.

#### **Approve Minutes**

Magistrate Nab made a motion to approve the minutes from the meeting on August 22, 2023. Magistrate Cable  $2^{nd}$ . All in favor. Motion carries.

#### **Budget Transfers**

Magistrate Long made a motion to approve the attached list of budget transfers. Magistrate Nab 2<sup>nd</sup>. All in favor. Motion carries.

#### **Invoice Approval**

Magistrate Nab made a motion to approve the attached list of invoices. Magistrate Cable 2<sup>nd</sup>. All in favor. Motion carries.

#### Appointments – Board of Ethics

Judge Wilhoite stated the District 1 and District 2 members of the ethics board have resigned. Judge Wilhoite asked Magistrate Long and Cable to recommend new members from their districts. Magistrate Nab made a motion to appoint Maguana Qualls for District 2 and Zach Spencer for District 1 members of the ethics board. Magistrate Cable  $2^{nd}$ . All in favor. Motion carries.

Judge Wilhoite also stated there is an appointment for the Board of Health. Judge Wilhoite made the recommendation to appoint Dr. Paul "Chip" Jahn to the Board of Health. Magistrate Long made a motion to approve the recommendation. Magistrate Nab 2<sup>nd</sup>. All in favor. Motion carries.

#### Bid Opening – Solid Waste Disposal

One bid was received for solid waste disposal from Rumpke Waste & Recycling. The bid is for October 1, 2023 through September 30, 2026. Bid form attached reflecting a yearly increase. Magistrate Nab made a motion to accept the bid. Magistrate Long 2<sup>nd</sup>. All in favor. Motion carries.

#### Bid Opening – Tennis/Pickleball Lighting

One bid was received for the lighting at the pickleball courts from Synergy Electrical Service in the amount of \$105,700. Magistrate Nab made a motion to accept the bid contingent on whether a timer is included. Magistrate Long  $2^{nd}$ . All in favor. Motion carries.

#### Bid Opening – Ambulance

One bid was received for a new ambulance from Rolland Specialty Vehicles and Products. The bid is for a 2022 F-550 4x4 XLT turbo diesel chassis, 2023 AEV TraumaHawk 172"x96"x72" conversion and graphics package in the amount of \$349,050. EMS/EMA director Tony Crutcher explained the price increase from the latest ambulance purchase. Magistrate Nab made a motion to accept the bid. Magistrate Cable 2<sup>nd</sup>. All in favor. Motion carries.

The purchase will be made with the ARPA funds.

#### Personnel Policy Manual

Magistrate Nab made a motion to have a first reading of the ordinance amending the employment policies and procedures manual of the Carroll County Fiscal Court. Magistrate Cable 2<sup>nd</sup>. All in favor. Motion carries.

County Attorney Nick Marsh read the ordinance by summary. The second reading will be held at the fiscal court meeting on October 10<sup>th</sup>.

#### Occupational Tax Ordinance – 2<sup>nd</sup> Reading & Final Adoption

Magistrate Nab made a motion to have the second reading of the ordinance amending ordinance no. 07-1113, an ordinance relating to the imposition and administration of an occupational license requirement, and payment of an occupational license tax by persons and business entities conducting businesses, occupations and professions within Carroll County, Kentucky. Magistrate Long 2<sup>nd</sup>. All in favor. Motion carries.

4 ayes 0 nays

County Attorney Nick Marsh read the ordinance by summary.

Magistrate Nab made a motion to adopt the ordinance. Magistrate Long 2<sup>nd</sup>. Motion carries.

ayes 1 nay

Magistrate Cable voted nay.

#### **ILead Work Study**

Magistrate Nab stated he spoke with ILead Director Jenna Gray about having a co-op student for assistance with starting live stream for the meetings. The co-op student will work 8 hours a week. All magistrates agreed.

#### <u>Stacy Rockaway – Congressman Thomas Massie's Office</u>

Stacy Rockaway introduced herself and informed the public of her duties.

#### **Public Comments**

A concerned citizen spoke about her thoughts of Northkey closing and the Michelle P waiver her family receives and will lose without Northkey. County Attorney Nick Marsh stated the county did not shut Northkey down, Northkey shut itself down. He also stated the county does not accept the waivers at this time but there are other ways to keep the waiver.

#### Judge's Comments

- The Tobacco Festival has requested use of the courtyard and the contribution that was budgeted.
- The work on Stafford Ridge is ongoing and there might be more to the project than anticipated.
- The pickleball courts are being marked this week.
- The Detention Center AC is out and working on getting bids for the project.
- The windows and doors are going to be replaced at the Senior Center after the damages.
- American Legion is hosting a First Responders lunch on September 16<sup>th</sup>. Wanted to thank them ahead of time for hosting the event.

#### **County Attorney Comments**

County Attorney Nick Marsh stated he had no comments but request an executive session regarding personnel.

#### **Magistrate Comments**

Long – Thanks everyone for coming. Thanks to the Road Department for the work on Notch Lick and stated there was a tree down on HWY 36 close to Nugent. Judge Wilhoite stated he had informed the State about the tree and will reach out to them again.

Cable – Thanks everyone for coming and he appreciates the comments. The KYSOC Hope Center has been ran very well and hopes to get everything worked out in the future.

Nab –

- Appreciates everyone for coming and asking questions.
- Proposed a committee for issues like the nuisance ordinance. County Attorney stated he would have to follow the laws regarding open meetings.
- Questioned the dump truck issue for the road department. County Attorney stated his opinion is to get in touch with the ARPA advisors and proposed it to be rebid.
- Asked if there was a date set for the Senior Center festival. Judge Wilhoite stated not at this time.
