Carroll County Fiscal Court Minutes September 24, 2024

A regular meeting of the Carroll County Fiscal Court was held on Tuesday, September 24, 2024. Members present were Judge Executive David Wilhoite, Magistrate Benjie Long, Magistrate Clay Cable, Magistrate Scott Nab and County Attorney Nick Marsh. Judge Wilhoite called the meeting to order at 9 a.m.

Pledge of Allegiance

Judge Wilhoite opened the meeting with the Pledge of Allegiance and a prayer.

Approve Minutes

Magistrate Cable made a motion to approve the minutes from the meeting on September 10, 2024. Magistrate Nab 2nd. All in favor. Motion carries.

Fleet Management Policy Ordinance – 2nd Reading & Final Adoption

Magistrate Long made a motion to have the second reading of the Ordinance adopting the Fleet Management Policy for Carroll County Government Vehicles and Equipment. Magistrate Nab 2nd. All in favor. Motion carries.

ARPA Resolution Proposal

Judge Wilhoite made a proposal to use the remainder of the ARPA funds on the following:

- 1. Dump bed cover for the new dump truck for the Road Department.
- 2. New basketball court lights using Syenergy Electrical Services.
- 3. A pool vacuum
- 4. iWorQ system for Solid Waste

Magistrate Nab stated the iWorQ system is budgeted and recommended using the ARPA funds for the AED's for County buildings. Treasurer Debra Cayton stated there is probably enough ARPA funds to purchase the AED's and iWorQ system. Magistrate Cable made a motion to approve the proposal including the AED's and removing the iWorQ system, if there's not enough funds. Magistrate Nab 2nd. All in favor. Motion carries.

Magistrate Cable made a motion to read the resolution authorizing the closure of the portion requested. Magistrate Long 2nd. All in favor. Motion carries.

<u>Establishing Code Enforcement Board Ordinance – 1st Reading</u>

Magistrate Nab made a motion to have the first reading of the ordinance creating the Code Enforcement Board and establishing the guidelines for enforcement. Magistrate Cable 2^{nd} . All in favor. Motion carries.

County Attorney Nick Marsh read the ordinance by summary.

Magistrate Cable made a motion to accept the first reading. Magistrate Long 2nd. All in favor. Motion carries.

- 911 Dispatch Greg Beck was absent.
- Hope Center Nancy Hilton provided the Court with the attached report. Nancy stated there was a typo on the 3-day sale total, it should say \$486.
- Solid Waste Director PJ Knight provided the Court with the attached report. PJ stated if the purchase of the iWorQ system will be after the end of October, we would need to go with a new sales representative.
- Animal Shelter Director Theresa Hehe provided the Court with the attached report. Magistrate
 Nab questioned the status on the flooring. County Attorney Nick Marsh received information
 today and will review it.
- Senior Center Director Frances Steurer provided the Court with a calendar for the Center.
 Frances stated that they will no longer be going to the YMCA due to changes in their Silver
 Sneaker program. Frances stated the Area Development District will pay for someone to get certified in Silver Sneakers and they will be moving their classes to the KYSOC pool. The Court also decided to look for a new van for the Center.

the project never took off. Magistrate Nab proposed for the project not to exceed \$14,000. Magistrate Nab made a motion to approve the repairs of the t-ball field, not to exceed \$14,000. Magistrate Long 2^{nd} . All in favor. Motion carries.
