# Carroll County Fiscal Court Minutes March 11, 2014

The regular meeting of the Carroll County Fiscal Court was held on March 11, 2014. Members present were Judge/Executive Harold "Shorty" Tomlinson, Magistrate Floyd Bowling, Magistrate Dean Miller and Magistrate Mark Bates. Judge Tomlinson called the meeting to order at 9 a.m., observing a moment of silence for those sick in the community and for our servicemen and women overseas.

Magistrate Bates noted his appreciation for former County Road Supervisor Doug Crawford, who retired this month after 27 years of service to the county.

#### **Approve Minutes**

#### College Update

Judge Tomlinson updated the court that things are still on target with the college project at this time.

#### <u>Heroin Forum</u>

Judge Tomlinson recently attended two forums on heroin addiction. One was local and one was held in Northern KY and hosted by Senator Mitch McConnell. Both events were well-received and provided insight into the area's growing heroin problem.

#### **Project Updates**

Three contractors attended the pre-bid meeting on Monday 3/10 for the NRCS project. Bids are due by 9 a.m. Thursday, with bid opening at 10 a.m. that day.

Carrollton Utilities is working on an issue with an exposed gas line due to river erosion. Judge Tomlinson is going to speak with NRCS officials to see if this is something they can assist with.

#### **County Audit**

The county audit has begun.

#### <u>Budget</u>

Judge Tomlinson asked court members to compile lists of requests for the FY 2014-2015 budget.

#### **County Road Report**

The county received approx. 100 ton of salt on Friday and expect another 100 ton within the next day. County road crews will be working on West Prong later this week, replacing a culvert.

#### State Road Report

The Milton-Madison Bridge closed at 2 a.m. this morning due to a beam shift and may not reopen until after the bridge slide is complete.

Judge Tomlinson is working to get in contact with Hinkle/OVA to find out the estimated start date on the Hwy 227/Park Avenue project.

Judge Tomlinson is awaiting an estimate from a contractor for repairs to the slide on Stafford Ridge.

Judge Tomlinson has made several calls to the railroad company concerning rough crossings.

#### **County Attorney Comments**

Electrical inspectors will need to have standardized rate and fee schedules approved through fiscal court. The county received a letter of intent from a private ambulance service that wishes to come into the county to provide services. After some discussion, the decision was made for the county attorney to file a letter of objection and request a hearing.

#### **Magistrate Comments**

Magistrate Bates reiterated the need for repairs to Stafford Ridge.

Magistrate Miller inquired about the donated building to the animal shelter.

Magistrate Miller discussed the need for the road dept. supervisor to have a county cell phone for county use only. All magistrates in agreement to add another cell phone for this position.

Magistrate Miller asked that the county donate money to the annual fireworks show at Point Park on July 4<sup>th</sup>. After some discussion, Magistrate Miller made a motion to donate \$7500 to the fireworks show. Magistrate Bowling 2<sup>nd</sup>. All in favor. Motion carries.
