- County roads for resurfacing this year are Carlisle Road, Sharon Road, small section of Sheehan Road, and between Kroger and VF from Hwy 227 to curve. OVA can go ahead with work now and bill after new fiscal year.
- Work on Hwy 42 from Dow to Ghent may be done in 2013.
- An estimate needed to apply for discretionary funding has been obtained for 11th Street/Lock Road.

- The high school Leadership Group meeting went well.
