

FEMA Grant Announcement

Our ambulance service has acquired a grant that will pay 95% of the cost of a lifting system to aid EMS in loading patients into two of our ambulances. The total cost is approx. \$52,000. The county will only be responsible for paying 25% of that cost, which will be \$2600.00.

EZ-IO is an alternative system for installing IV when conventional methods cannot be utilized. The cost for this system is \$3400 for all 4 ambulances. This has been recommended by our Medical Director. Magistrates agreed to the purchase.

Transportation Resolution

Magistrate Bates made a motion to authorize the attached Resolution for Rural and Municipal Aid. Magistrate Miller 2nd. All in favor. Motion carries.

Transportation Agreement

Magistrate Bowling made a motion authorizing Judge Tomlinson to sign the attached agreement in the amount of \$120,000 for the Buffalo Creek Bridge. The county will be reimbursed \$96,000 of the total cost. Magistrate Bates 2nd. All in favor. Motion carries.

Jennifer Willhoite was on hand to explain a grant opportunity for the Sheriff’s Office that will pay for an officer’s salary and benefits 75% for 3 years and then the county would have to pay 100% on the fourth year. After some discussion, the court gave their support for pursuing the grant.

County Road Report

Magistrate Bates made a motion to approve the purchase of a new truck and spreader off the state contract in the amount of \$46,069.00. Magistrate Bowling 2nd. All in favor. Motion carries.

North American Salt Company was the lowest bidder for salt for Carroll County in the amount of \$63.59 per ton for 1000 ton requested. This is less than the price last year.

County Judge Comments

Magistrate Miller made a motion to approve a request from the Carroll County Fair Board for an additional \$10,000 donation. Magistrate Bowling 2nd. All in favor. Motion carries.
