

Winter Weather Problems

During the recent bout of winter weather, the road depart has used 610 ton of road salt at a cost of nearly \$42,000. Road Laborers have worked approximately 120 OT hours as well. Water pipes burst at the Senior Center resulting in some water damage. Water lines have frozen multiple times and even resulted in a line break at the courthouse. Various leaks at both KYSOC and County Park are expected. Potholes have already begun to cause issues.
